**Grant Puts "Fathering" Books on Prospect Park Library Shelves in Time for
Father's Day; "Grandparenting" and Pre-School Non-Fiction Titles Also New**

PROSPECT PARK, PA—A number of new titles devoted to fathers' unique parenting skills have arrived at the Prospect Park Library in time to mark the June celebration of Father's Day.

"Most parenting books are geared toward mothers or general parenting," notes Library Director Mary Alice Walsh. "These books focus on a father's special relationship with his children. We are delighted to add these books to our collection and give our patrons additional, personally useful resources."

The fathering books are among 25 new titles provided by state funding through a Library Service Technology Act (LSTA) grant received by the Delaware County Library System. The grant specifically updates parenting titles, and Prospect Park's collection also includes a number of new volumes intended for grandparents, as well as quality non-fiction titles for pre-schoolers.

"This grant provides a nice addition for our youngest readers, since educational non-fiction is not so commonly available for this group," adds Walsh. "These children's titles are well-done and include a variety of non-fiction topics that children will enjoy."

Titles for pre-schoolers include *Keeping You Healthy*, *Egypt ABCs: About People and Places of Egypt*, *Busy Bees in Your Backyard*, and *Australia ABCs: About People and Places of Australia*.

The new fathering books include *101 Ways to be a Terrific Sports Parent*, *The Expectant Father*, *How Men Have Babies*, *The Don't Sweat Guide for Dads* and *Becoming a Father*.

New titles for grandparents include *Grandma and Grandpa's Big Book of Fun*, *Off Your Rocker: The Ultimate Guide for Grandparents*, *The Grandparent Guide*, *Grandparents as Parents*, *Raising your Children's Children*, and *Chicken Soup for the Grandparent's Soul*.
